AOP Beaujolais-Villages

CHARACTERISTICS

- Appellation : Beaujolais-Villages
- Color : Red
- Vintage: 2023
- Grape variety: Gamay

VINEYARDS

Located in the heart of the Beaujolais region, in the village of Salles-Arbuissonnas, Domaine de Croifolie, a family estate for 4 generations, extends over 8 hectares. The vines from which this wine is made range in age from 65 to over 100 years, and come from granite soil.

VINIFICATION AND AGEING

Harvested by hand. Parcel-by-parcel selection of grapes from the oldest vines. Vatting by conveyor belt and devatting by gravity to avoid damaging the grapes. Traditional vinification, maceration for 10 to 15 days and ageing in vats for 7 to 8 months. Very light filtration to preserve all the wine's qualities.

TASTING

Color : Deep garnet.

Nose : red fruit aromas

Palate : round, silky tannins, structured and long.

Cellaring : 6 years.

Wine/Food pairing : Goes well with game, grilled prime rib and spicy dishes.
